MUSICAL GHOST was rated along outside, rallied wide into the stretch, responded when roused and was going away late under a drive. CORNISH SNOW was rated inside, angled out for running room in upper stretch and finished gamely to earn the place award. THE KAISER was rated along three wide and finished gamely outside. MYSTERIOUS MOLL was rated outside, put in a three wide run on the turn and stayed on well to the finish. SHOW KING raced close up inside while under wraps and finished well despite traffic problems along the inside in the stretch. RUDIRUDY raced wide and lacked a solid finishing kick. ROGERS PASS chased the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. PUNCHER set the pace and gave way before three quarters.
