FLY WITH KARAKORUM raced close up while three wide, responded when roused in upper stretch and was along late. KINGS EMPRESS contested the pace from the outside, drew clear in the stretch and dug in gamely to the wire. GLITTERING RACKET raced close up along the inside, came wide into the stretch and finished well. MAIN STREAM was bumped after the start, was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and was going well late. VROOM HILDA was bumped after the start, raced inside and posed no real threat. ELECTRICAL CARLITA contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. FRENCH JEANNETTE was bumped after the start, raced wide throughout and tired.
