**Footnotes**

PROTESTING was outrun in hand, swung six wide at the quarter pole and closed well to edge the runner-up in the final strides. SENADA raced in the middle of the pack, rallied five wide inside the winner at the quarter pole and was outfinished by that one in the final strides. VEE raced just off the pace to the turn, steadied along the rail in midstretch and finished willingly. RHYS steadied in traffic at the quarter pole, swung five wide and rallied belatedly. KITTY IN A TIZZY set the pace on the rail and tired in upper stretch. LOST AT DAWN lodged a three wide move to reach contention on the turn and flattened out. TRIBECA steadied along the rail in the early stages and failed to mount a serious rally. SAPPHIRE MINK pressed the pace into upper stretch and steadied sharply while tiring at the eighth pole. MEHNDI checked early, steadied sharply in traffic on the turn and gave way.
