PERVIS sat reserved off the inside for nearly three-quarters, spun three wide into the stretch under a drive, made contact with SOUL SILENCE a short distance into the stretch drive, with the momentum from each bearing some responsibility, closed readily under encouragement, grabbing away the lead in the last jump. EAST INDIES quickly established command, was rated towards the inside on an uncontested lead, was let out soon after entering the stretch, dug in with good determination, but got nipped right at the finish line. AFLEET'S ACCLAIM saved ground and proved no match for the top twosome. SOUL SILENCE loosely prompted the pacesetter from the outside, was under encouragement turning for home, wedged between rivals, bumped with the top one in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths, was steadied then tired. MAKE MY MOVE failed to menace. WHARTON WIZARD had a ground-saving journey and was outrun. An objection lodged by the trainer of SOUL SILENCE against the rider of PERVIS alleging interference in the stretch was not allowed.
