HARLAN'S HELLO vied between rivals down the backstretch and around the turn, was set down to a hard drive turning for home, inched up bit by bit throughout a spirited stretch duel and got up near the wire to prevail. RIPPLES N' WAVES settled along the rail soon after the start, disputed the pace with two other opponents throughout the opening three-quarters, shook off SMALL TOWN TALK at this juncture of the contest and went one on one with the winner thereafter, was set down entering the stretch, battled gamely to the end, but came up short. POLICE CHATTER left the inside and was taken into the two path departing the backstretch, rallied mildly to grab the show, while never posing a threat to the top twosome at any point. BREAK UP THE GAME off the inside, was placed in the four path midway on the turn and put to a prolonged drive, got outfinished. SMALL TOWN TALK three wide, argued the pace the widest of a threesome for three-quarters before backing away. CROSSED THE LINE faded off a ground-saving journey.
