Footnotes

ZIPTRONIC worked his way into a forward position, ranged up to increase the pressure on the pacesetter nearing the end of the backstretch, contested the pace two wide, with COUNT CATAMOUNT lurking just behind the pair of front runners taking the three path, made a successful bid late on the turn to grab away the lead and got set down, added to the advantage during the ensuing furlong, continued on with good determination to hold off the fast-closing runner up. FISHERMAN'S WHARF unhurried for the opening half from the outside, was placed five wide at the head of the stretch, got straightened away and charged home with good energy to secure second. SUSTAINABLE FOREST sat within range from off the inside, tipped into four path shortly after settling into upper stretch, held on well for the show. TIGER WILLIE settled into midpack along the outside, was kept reserved for the initial half, commenced to rally in earnest three wide in upper stretch, bobbed coming to the eighth pole, continued onward, paused behind rivals about a sixteenth later, re gathered his stride and made up some real estate in the late stages. PRIME OBSESSION saved ground for nearly a half, angled out coming into the lane and gained

ground to improve position. COUNT CATAMOUNT raced three wide, was put to encouragement chasing an embattled pair during the run around the bend, remained a prominent factor until mid lane before backing away. EZZY out a step at the break, was pulled off the nearest opponent, underwent a three wide pursuit, had no significant closing kick. MITIGATION tracked the front runners taking the inside route, was taken off the rail for the stretch run, stumbled taking a bad step in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, weakened departing the furlong grounds then was vanned off after the finish. ALLTIFFEDOFF rode the rail until the midstretch, vacated the premises only to clear a fading rival at that stage, was always outrun. HAVE YOU EVER spurred from the inside for most of the way around the turn, faltered.
