EFFICIENT FRONTIER was rated outside, rallied wide into the stretch, dug in gamely and prevailed under a drive. SOUTHERN IVY was outrun early, responded when roused in upper stretch and finished gamely outside. RUTHIAN raced with the pace while between rivals and stayed on gamely to the finish. KERATOID'S CHUBBS raced close up inside and stayed on gamely through the stretch. QUEEN LIVIA set the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. WINDSONG raced with the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. CLASSICALROSE came wide into the stretch and had no rally. HEY HEY SUNNY was hustled along early but had no response. SANTO MIO had no response when roused. HEMLINE tired.
