PLEASANT FICTION quickly showed in front, set the pace while in hand, responded when roused and drew clear under a drive. HARBOR MASTER pressed the pace from the outside and dug in gamely to earn the place award. AARON'S CLASSIC was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside. ADIOS CIAO BYE BYE was bumped after the start and bothered a bit between rivals then raced close up along the inside while under wraps and weakened on the rail late. SARDEGNA was bumped after the start, raced wide throughout and lacked a rally. KRUNCHER stumbled after the start, was bumped, dropped back early, came wide into the stretch and had no rally. WARM COOKIE hit the gate at the start, raced inside and had no response when roused.
