Footnotes

STRATTON'S GIRL set the pace under pressure for a half, shook loose in midstretch and drew off under right hand urging. PRIMED TO BE READY chased four wide, gained at the quarter pole and closed late in the middle of the track to gain the place. AMERICAN LAND raced inside in the middle of the pack, angled between horses on the turn, rallied in upper stretch and lost the place in deep stretch. IMANDRA pressed the pace in the two path and gave way inside the eighth pole. WHY BECAUSE steadied in traffic early, advanced three wide on the turn and flattened out. RIGHT REWARD was outrun after breaking slowly. BEST BOOK steadied along the rail at the half mile pole, was in hand on the turn and lacked a late response while tiring. CAT GRACE was never a factor.
