OBLIGINGLY prompted the pace in the two path, surged to the front in midstretch and edged clear late. STRASBOURG set the pace into midstretch and yielded grudgingly. GREATSILVERSAINT was outrun after breaking slowly, raced well back then closed late along the rail to gain a share. TALL POPPI chased between horses for six furlongs and tired. BIMINI failed to mount a serious rally. WHY NOT BE PERFECT was never a factor. FULL LIQUIDITY lodged a three wide bid at the quarter pole and flattened out.
