RISKY RACHEL the early leader, conceded the front to **THOSE LION EYES** approaching the half mile pole, was taken outward to sit perched just off that rival's hind quarters, received some light encouragement a short way into the run around the bend and gradually ranged up to the leader, drew alongside as that pair turned for home, was asked for more run when the stretch duel commenced, finally went by in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and edged away being hand urged to the end. **THOSE LION EYES** away well from the starting gate, resisted the rider's attempt to rate, seemingly dragging herself to the front nearing the end of the backstretch, showed the way from the two path, with the top one in close pursuit directly to the outside, was put to the test by the winner heading for the top of the lane, got called upon, offered good resistance until the sixteenth pole, relinquished the lead but continued on willingly enough to fend off her stable mate for place honors. **LADY VI** set up in the pocket, angled outward for the final furlong and displayed a mild kick. **SNEAKIN UP** outrun for a half, came four wide for the stretch drive and failed to menace. **THERE GOES MOLLY** off slowly, was never in contention. **HOW'S BAYOU** four wide departing the backstretch, was through after completing a half.
