## Footnotes

GIMME CREDIT off the inside throughout, was three wide down the backstretch, before scampering back into the two path in time for the run around the far turn, moved up into good striking distance, angled three wide in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole gearing up for the stretch drive, responded positively once given his cue, took over leaving the furlong grounds and drew clear under hand encouragement. MR. VEGAS lunged at the break, moved up willingly and assumed control, was rated on a loosely-contested lead, placed near the inside, continued along on the same scenario until the quarter pole, was let out and edged away from the competition during the ensuing furlong, proved no match for the top one, yielding readily but continued onward with good energy for the place. HEAR THE FOOTSTEPS saved ground, angled outward in upper stretch, moved up before flattening out a bit during the last eighth. COMPLIANCE OFFICER attended the pacesetter from the outside until the quarter pole before backing away. SKY BLUE PINK saved ground until the five-sixteenths pole and lacked the needed response. THUNDER CHIEF was no factor. MIDNIGHT BILLY underwent a three wide to four wide journey and folded. ALLTIFFEDOFF tracked from the inside, turned for home with a clear lane along the rail and came up empty. MR. ENRICO three wide around the far turn, tired. RAFFINATOR saved ground until the quarter pole while trailing throughout.
