HANNIE'S CANDY showed good speed while in hand, took over on the second turn, drew away when roused and remained well clear under a drive. BIJOU was outrun early, rallied four wide on the second turn, and was up to get the place prize. ETOUFEE was outrun early, rallied five wide on the second turn and finished well outside. SCORCHING dropped back early, raced inside and finished well inside. CASTLE SPRING raced close up early, put in a wide run on the second turn and had little left for the stretch drive. CULLBERG BALLE (IRE) was rated along early, raced inside and had no rally. QUIETLY ELEGANT was outrun early, put in a wide run on the second turn and tired in the final furlong. SETTLING MIST raced inside and tired. BAL BOREE quickly showed in front, set the pace for three quarters and tired. EUCALYPTUS HILL chased the pace and tired. CHARMEDANDANGEROUS raced close up early, put in a three wide run on the second turn and tired in the stretch. WHYTWOCA YMAN broke slowly, raced wide and tired.
