GAL O GAL was bumped at the start, was rated along early, rallied four wide approaching the stretch, dug in gamely outside and prevailed under a drive. YOUNG STAR quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside and dug in gamely through the stretch. MADEIRA MIST (IRE) was pinched back at the start, was outrun early, rallied wide and finished well outside. LOJO chased the pace along the inside and weakened in the stretch. PERFECT ENERGY stumbled at the start, pressed the pace from the outside and tired in the final furlong. BRANDALA raced inside and had no rally. LONGINGTOBEME raced three wide and tired. ARTIST JOHANNA (ARG) raced close up while three wide and tired in the stretch.
