Footnotes

TEAKS NORTH took up role of primary pursuer soon after the start, stalked from the two path without applying serious pressure during the initial stages, crept up to issue a challenge in earnest approaching the quarter pole, with a closely-bunched up group lurking a short distance from behind, responded positively when given his cue to scamper away to a comfortable advantage, partially aided by having each of the innermost members lacking optimal racing clearance at that juncture, remained safely in front under good handling. HYPER was unhurried for much of the opening half, picked up the pace when let out a notch, scurried into contention, looping by SKY BLAZER and tucking along the inside route once sufficiently clear, bided time along it the rest of the way down the backstretch and on the far turn as well, remained under a good hold, lacking suitable options as the field neared the quarter pole, entered the lane mired in traffic, tried several times to squeeze along the rail to escape the predicament, but had to be either steadied or taken hold after each try, gained room to finally launch a rail bid when the now-weakening former pacesetter drifted into the two path with about an eighth to go, was the innermost of three to depart the furlong grounds on nearly even terms, mustered up a good kick to edge away from them for place honors. QUICK CASABLANCA (CHI) reserved in the two path for the opening three-quarters, was attempting to advance towards the winner from between rivals at the furlong marker, flattened out. SKY BLAZER was given permission and was out on the track before the others, came away with no apparent mishap and quickly tucked along the rail, lost position when looped by the second place finisher down the backstretch, continued to save ground on the far turn and into upper lane, loosely drafted behind the luckless runner up and as a result idled behind rivals too during the opening phase of the stretch drive, underwent a laborious maneuver by altering course to be five wide by the eighth pole, mustered up a mild response to earn the final major slice of the pot. REFLECTING raced three wide around both turns, was already under a drive entering the stretch, had no kick. JOAN'S CHOICE shook free of the competition proceeding down the homestretch and was guided over to the rail, rated kindly on an open lead, had the pressure intensify upon departing the backstretch, was put to a stern test before arriving at the quarter pole and was quickly set down, yielded when unable to keep pace with the eventual winner, drifted out slightly at the tail end of the furlong grounds and tired.
