**Footnotes**

NOAH'S ARCH stalked three wide for six furlongs, edged closer while launching a bid from outside on the turn then closed steadily to get up in the final seventy yards. INTERFERENCE pressed the pace between horses, dropped back slightly on the turn, angled out in upper stretch then finished willingly to narrowly gain the place. HAVE YOU EVER set the pace along the inside into midstretch and yielded in the final sixteenth. PROPENSITY was outrun for six furlongs, swung four wide while gaining at the quarter pole and rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. NEW YORK HOLIDAY was well placed along the rail to the top of the stretch and lacked a late response. PATH TO SUCCESS steadied along the inside midway down the backstretch, raced well back to the turn and failed to mount a serious rally. ROYAL LORD never reached contention while angling five wide at the top of the stretch. MARSCAPONI was under a firm hold while steadying on the backstretch, swung wide on the turn and gave way.
