### Footnotes

MONTE CARLO was reserved for a half, circled five wide at the quarter pole, gained steadily to take the lead seventy yards out and edged clear late. PEGASIAN raced in midpack, advanced four wide to reach contention on the turn and finished willingly to gain the place. SLEVIN was fractious in the gate at the start, broke in the air coming out well behind the field, trailed far back for a half, swung out in upper stretch and finished full of run but could not get up. KATSKILL BAY moved up along the rail at the half mile pole, got through along the rail to take the lead midway on the turn, led into deep stretch and yielded late. JAYSTONE set or forced the pace in the two path for five furlongs and tired. KNIFE AND FORK raced well back for a half, swung five wide at the quarter pole and failed to threaten. WON GREAT CLASSIC steadied in traffic along the backstretch and failed to threaten thereafter. HEAD HEART HOOFF pressed the pace from outside and gave way on the turn. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the start of the race before the result was declared official.
