SEATTLE SMOOTH was reserved while racing in hand along the inside on the backstretch, saved ground while gaining on the turn, waited behind a wall of horses entering the stretch, altered course to the four path for clear sailing leaving the three-sixteenths pole then closed gradually under steady left hand urging to wear down COLOR ME UP in the final strides. COLOR ME UP settled in good position along the backstretch, launched a rally between horses midway on the turn, surged to the front in upper stretch, opened a clear advantage in midstretch, continued on the front into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. SEA CHANTER raced in good position while three wide along the backstretch, swung four wide while mounting a bid at the quarter pole, made a run to threaten in midstretch and finished willingly for a share. GRANTED TIGER set the pace in hand along the backstretch, led into upper stretch and tired from her early efforts. STRIKING TOMISUE raced just outside the winner for five furlongs, swung five wide at the quarter pole and lacked a strong closing bid. ARE WE DREAMIN pressed the leaders three wide for a half, dropped back on the turn and steadily tired thereafter.
