Footnotes

POCKET COWBOYS set the pace inside, shook loose in upper stretch and drew off under good handling. GOOD KARMA was reserved early, split horses midway on the turn, swung four wide and closed late to narrowly gain the place. COPS FEVER chased three wide, lodged a bid on the turn and weakened late. FIRST OF TEN raced well back for a mild swung wide and rallied belatedly. BISHOP OF NOLA raced just off the pace between horses to the turn and tired. SOUTH FOURTH ST. pressed the winner from outside for seven furlongs and gave way. SLAMM'N LOU steadied inside entering the backstretch, raced up close along the rail and tired on the turn. ELDER SKATESMAN was never a factor.
