W. W.'S LADY'S MAN quickly made the front, was taken inward eventually tucking into the two path nearing the nine-sixteenths marker, cut the pace under the watchful eye of the second place finisher, turned for home with that rival just off his hind quarters, received some attention with the stick on the right shoulder before being cut loose at the three-sixteenths pole, steadily drew away from that station to the finish line. FLAT BOLD raced three wide, prompted the winner under a firm hold for the initial half, was given his cue with an eighth to go, got out kicked. LEAVE OF ABSENCE was taken in hand midway down the backstretch, as the top one was setting into the two path, gave chase throughout the run around the bend, was under a drive spinning three wide into the stretch, proved no match. HE'S SO CHIC off a beat slowly, swung six wide into upper stretch, displayed a mild stretch response to improve position. NOBLE'S PROMISE took the inside route, was roused at the five-sixteenths pole, faltered. TEMECULA CREEK under a drive four wide into the lane, came up empty. CREPE AU SUCRE broke outward and trailed throughout.
