JOBURG STAR worked his way to a clear advantage after negotiating the opening quarter, was well out in the track for a good portion of the going down the backstretch, but tucked to be about two wide for the run around the bend, began to edge away from the field from midpoint on the turn, held a healthy margin leading the competition into the stretch and got called upon, completed the race comfortably in front, despite drifting outward slightly in the late stages. CREA'S LAW forwardly placed in the initial stages, dropped back slightly, was put to some encouragement to prevent any significant loss of ground, continued to fall back nonetheless from the three-eighths pole as the winner shook free, held on well enough at the end to salvage second. INDIGENE CHARM swung outward to be five wide by the three-sixteenths pole, mustered up a mild stretch response for the show. WARRIOR UP broke in the air, making contact with NOBLE'S PROMISE as a result, ducked inward to take the inside route around the turn, cut the corner already under encouragement, flattened out. AFLEET'S ACCLAIM coaxed from the get-go, raced from off the rail, was under a drive for most of the way around the turn, tired and was vanned off after the finish. KID WANDO bumped from both sides at the start, chased the winner three wide for a half, folded.
