Footnotes

BARBIE WIRE was taken in hand by the pilot in reaction to the antics coming from the second place finisher approaching the end of the backstretch, raced along the outside on the turn, swung outward until in the four path entering the stretch, got straightened away and gained ground readily to arrive at the eighth pole first, albeit ahead of another twosome by the slimmest of margins, edged away, drifted out several paths with under a sixteenth remaining and held on safely. ZIP UP made light contact with the left side of the starting gate after taking the initial out of it towards the inside, showed early keenness, with the rider grabbing hold on the reins to tone it down, was quickly sent over to the rail, was tipped off it coming to the end of the backstretch, at the time the rival directly up front along the inside route, that being DISTANT CAT was unsettled, became rank and came out a bit, requiring the rider to check at the half mile pole, dropped back to last with the loss of ground and momentum, got going back properly soon afterwards and launched a run to reach the middle of the field halfway around the bend, strode greenly for a couple of jumps with the jockey increasing his pressure on the reins once more, finished the run around the bend and spun into the stretch three wide, went onward for a short distance then altered course into the five path, kicked into her best stride after making this last maneuver, got carried out when intimidated by the top one in the final seventy yards, gamely secured second. STREET TRICK slipped off the rail coming to the five-sixteenths pole, departed that station between opponents, finished willingly down the lane to take the show. TIZ TERESA three wide at the top of the turn, ranged up steadily on the front runners, poked a head down in front by the quarter pole and was called upon, fought well for the next eighth before releasing the lead, then weakened steadily thereafter. SWEET POTATO three wide at the three-eighths pole, was put to urging giving chase on the turn, folded. DADDY LOVES GOLD sparred for command from the outside, remained a prominent factor until midstretch before giving way. DISTANT CAT was guided over onto the inside route in the early going, appeared unsettled proceeding down the backstretch, at times riding the rail and at other times drifting in the direction of the two path, faltered. BRAIDED dueled along the inside for a bit more than a half and tired.
