Footnotes

NIGHT OFFICER saved ground, got asked for a response coming to the end of the bend, was a short distance past the three-sixteenths pole when angled outward, took off in earnest after the pacesetter, drew even with about a sixteenth remaining, needed only a couple of more jumps to secure the front, dug in well late to turn back the runner up. HOOFIT (NZ) cut the corner into the lane, altered course into the four path coming to the eighth pole, settled into his best stride, charging down the center of the course full of run to procure the place. NEXT QUESTION shook free in the early stages and was guided over to the rail well before reaching the end of the backstretch, set swift splits, was set down for the stretch, had the winner draw abreast in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, relinquished in short order and eventually weakened into the show slot. SAINT PETE chased the leader from the outside, weakened in the final furlong. YIELD BOGEY off the inside, commenced the stretch run four wide, had no rally. MARTINI MADNESS raced along the outside and failed to menace. PACIFIC OCEAN underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn, under some encouragement for a good portion of it, gave way.
