**Footnotes**

STAR VESTA away well from the starting gate, moved up to dispute the pace from the outside, stayed latched on to AUSTRALIS PRINCESS while applying pressure for the initial three splits, got asked for run turning for home and responded positively, kicked away to emerge from the furlong grounds holding her biggest advantage, held sway, driving. TONIGAIL unhurried for nearly three-quarters, picked up interest angling outward late on the turn, shadowed DATTS APPEALING altering course towards the middle of the course in upper stretch, settling to be about four wide once the maneuver was done, got straightened away and displayed a good kick to garner the place. G. A. EMPRESS content to bring up the back of the pack, swung three wide into upper stretch, came home with good energy to secure the show. DATTTT APPEALING was guided closer to the rail coming to the end of the backstretch, was asked for run while spinning into the stretch, altered to the outside at the three-sixteenths marker for better racing clearance, flattened out. FLEET ALLAIRE left the rail shortly after reaching the turn, launched a mild bid to reach contention by midstretch before backing away. IN HER HEY DAY coaxed along the outside on the turn while stalking the front runners, folded. CRANBERRY QUEEN three wide at the three-eighths pole, tired. AUSTRALIS PRINCESS bobbled at the start, went on to secure the top soon afterwards and tucked along the rail, argued to maintain control until upper stretch and faltered. MEGASPIEL (GB) underwent a three wide journey, was set down early on turn, stopped abruptly a few strides later.
