Footnotes

A BOY NAMED EM ranged up to contest the pace nearing the end of the backstretch, was the widest of three vying for the lead, while taking the four path on the turn, had the battle spill over into upper stretch before shaking free, proceeded to draw off the last eighth, under slightly lighter handling in the late stages than at the beginning of the stretch run. FESTIVE SPIRIT rode the rail down the backstretch, was taken and placed along the outside for the run around the bend, turned for home and got set down, bumped with JET SET CAT in midstretch, while coming inward slightly as the previously mentioned rival was coming outward, continued to race as a team with that opponent leaving the eighth pole, came in much sharply a second time after some right handed stick work, bumped harder with the same foe, continued onward to get up for the place. HANDSOME HARBOR three wide, fought for command from between foes until upper stretch, weakened in the final furlong. JET SET CAT near the inside, closed the gap on the embattled threesome on the turn, was under a drive taking the four path into the stretch, made contact twice with the runner up during the stretch drive, once in the vicinity of the eighth pole and then past the sixteenth marker, failed to re gain interest after the latter. PERSONAL ASSISTANT was briefly in hand after breaking a step to the outside, made the top in short order, raced in the two path, arguing for command as the inner member of a trio, kept up the pursuit until upper stretch and tired. CHIEF WILD EAGLE along the inside, came up empty when asked for a response at the three-eighths pole. FLIPION off the inside, was through after going a half.
