BECKY'S KITTEN travelled in the four path on the turn, turned for home and took off after the front runners in earnest, came home relentlessly, gamely getting the nod at the wire. DEERSLAYER contested the pace from the outside with METAURUS just about from the start, was the first of the two combatants to have the rider commit to some kind of encouragement, doing so in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, with the aforementioned rival following suit a few strides later, sparred more intensely as the front runners made their way from upper to midstretch, all the while clinging to the narrowest of leads, felt the presence of several others for the final sixteenth, dug in stubbornly only to get nipped at the wire. ONZAIN was hustled into midpack, got placed to a good hold having achieved the goal and remained under it for nearly a half thereafter, stayed within range, got set down spinning into the stretch, split rivals a short distance beyond the sixteenth pole, sustained the momentum to loom a bold threat but missed. TAWAARED three wide off a

disputed pace, held on willingly, but had to settle for the last major slice of the pot. THE VIN MAN along the inside, was asked for run leaving the three-eighths pole, lacked the needed response. METAURUS argued for command along the rail, was put to urging just prior to the quarter pole, fought with vigor before weakening the final sixteenth. WAYWARDWILLIE off the inside, was already under encouragement turning for home, failed go gain ground appreciably then was vanned off after the finish. MOOSE MAN three wide, was under the whip entering the stretch, had no rally. METROLOGY devoid of early foot, was always outrun. RAGING WIT failed to menace.
