Footnotes

HEBERT HALL sat forwardly placed in the three path departing the backstretch, was under some coaxing from the pilot keeping watch on an embattled pair a short distance up ahead, ranged up to increase his presence during the later stages of the run around the turn, spun into the lane and was quickly called upon, gained a slim advantage past the eighth pole, then dug in well late to fend off the belated challenge coming from SPECIAL SELECTION to preserve the decision. SPECIAL SELECTION stayed within striking distance from off the inside, found himself boxed in approaching the quarter pole, entered the stretch, gradually altered course to the outside making his way through the furlong grounds, was put to encouragement once fully clear, closed in with good late foot en route for the place. EL CORRIENTE three wide at the top of the turn, was swung out into the four path exiting it, had a good finish down the

outside of the course to earn the show award. D'ORO DANCER patiently tracked the front runners from the pocket, launched an abbreviated run from the head of the stretch to loom a threat with an eighth to go, flattened out. STONELESS vied for command from the inside, stayed in the thick of things before weakening in the final furlong. CALL UP THE CHIEF was eased into the two path coming to the quarter pole, came up empty when called upon. GINGER'S JOE pulled on the bit initially while taking the inside route, vacated the premises midway on the turn, fanned outward turning for home, settling to be six wide by the three-sixteenths pole, lacked the needed response. WINTER NOW got away two beats slow, continued to be sluggish for most of the way down the backstretch, was in the four wide at the half mile pole, entered the stretch a bit wider and made no impact. POPPA LOVES MAMBO contested the pace from the outside, under a snug hold for a good portion of the opening half, gave way.
