Footnotes

READY FOR THERAPY three wide departing the backstretch, joined the pace dispute soon afterwards, going at it head to the head with the runner up, had the battle spill over into the lane, with both combatants now put to a drive, continued on resolutely down the lane and gamely got up. THERAPY assumed a forward position right from the get-go, was involved as the middle member of three-way tussle for most of the way down the backstretch, had the fighter down along the rail, that being LIMINEUSE, get checked out of it leaving the half mile pole, continued along in the two path, on nearly even terms with the top one the rest of the way to the quarter pole, reached that station, clinging to the barest of leads, arrived at the end of the furlong grounds, with no change in position, relinquished reluctantly and had to settle for being a very determined second best. HOT RENDEZVOUS was briefly on the inside route down the backstretch, chose the two path as the one to take around the bend, entered the stretch and was called upon, altered course a couple of paths outward during the run through the furlong grounds, held on well for the show, despite making no significant headway on the fighting front runners. WILD FRANCES sent over to the rail coming to the end of the backstretch, lacked the necessary stretch response. DON'T HOOK MY HALO along the inside in the early going, swung four wide into the stretch already having been placed to solid encouragement, made no impact. LUMINEUSE broke alertly, argued for control from the rail, with another pair to the outside for nearly all the way from the gate to the half mile pole, was still when latched onto to the other two when the pilot checked, fell back slightly yet remained in range, head cocked noticeably to the right after the rider had applied the brakes, appeared choppy-gaited prior to cutting the corner into the lane, was asked for a response and gave it launching an abbreviated run starting from about the three-sixteenths pole, failed to sustain it and tired. SHAKE SENORA bobbed at the break, contested the pace as the widest of three down the backstretch, couldn't maintain the pace and steadily tired. MCGILLYCUDDY'S GAL was placed in the five path at the three-sixteenths pole to no avail.
