SAYLER'S CREEK saved ground in range of the front patiently handled, cut the corner roused into the stretch, angled out to the three path a furlong from home, closed well with a good kick to take over inside the final sixteenth and inched away late on. MAJESTIC RAFFY three to four wide in mid pack, made a bold advance from three furlongs out three to four wide into contention swinging three wide into upper stretch, rallied to seize command a furlong out, dug in under threat and was caught inside the final sixteenth while safe for the place honors. PRECIOUS METAL three wide in mid pack, came under encouragement midway on the far turn, spun five wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick and just got the show honors in the last jump. KISS OF THUNDER attended the pace along the inside, took closer order and took over narrowly when placed to encouragement at the five-sixteenths, cut the

corner for home, dug in under challenge from MAJESTIC RAFFY, got headed a furlong out, kept on mildly to the wire but was nailed for the show on the line. WAYWARD SAILOR broke in at the start squeezing back TIZ GIANNI against PRECIOUS METAL, showed the way just off the inside in hand while attended to the inside, came under urging nearing the five-sixteenths, got headed for command at that station, cornered just off the inside for home and weakened in the stretch. GRIFFIN ROCK three wide towards the rear, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, angled six wide into upper stretch, passed tired rivals while unable to make an impact. BEDOUIN NOW just off the inside towards the rear, came under a ride three furlongs out, never threatened. SUMMIT COUNTY just off the pace tracking from the two path, came under urging three wide at the three-eighths, angled three to four wide for home, weakened in the stretch. AMBER COAST saved ground in mid pack, got ridden along midway on the far turn, tired in the drive. TIZ GIANNI was forced to steady at the start when squeezed between foes as the appropriately named WAYWARD SAILOR broke inwards, saved ground near the rear, came under urging three furlongs out, angled five to six wide into upper stretch and never menaced.
