GOLDEN DAMSEL pressed the pace from the outside while in hand, drew away when roused and widened under a hand ride. THE NAME WAS GONE ducked in at the start, was bumped after the start, raced three wide and rallied outside to get the place prize. TRAVELATOR quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside, was no match for the winner and tired in the final furlong. BIOGIO'S BEAUTY ducked out at the start, was bumped after the start, raced wide and tired in the stretch. LAPIS was steadied on the backstretch, chased outside and tired after a half mile. HANSELINA was rank in the starting gate, chased the pace along the rail and tired. BANKER'S MINT was roughed up between rivals at the start, stumbled, dropped back, raced wide and tired.
