SENIORITA SWINGER went head to head with FOREST JAZZY for the initial quarter, was taken back shortly afterwards, attempted to split rivals approaching the turn, but steadied while lacking room, remained in contention along the inside, angled out upper stretch, splitting rivals to gain clearance, quickly ducked back to the rail, then gradually wore down the leader under strong handling. SHOPIT raced three wide, drove to take command approaching the head of the stretch, dug in when winner ranged alongside and held stubbornly to the wire. ALLURING TUNE hit the gate at the start, saved ground during the run around the bend, was stacked six wide at the top of the lane and came home with a good rally. BUONA SERA broke awkwardly, raced wide and tired. FOREST JAZZY contested the pace from the outside for a quarter, inherited the lead when SENORITA SWINGER chose to back off, angled over to the inside once clear, showed the way to the top of the stretch and gave way.
