PAPA FREUD contently stalked the pacesetter from the outside, began to close in upon departing the backstretch, was only a short distance behind the leader as the pair spun into the stretch, was set down, took off and shook free, held sway, driving. HUDSON MIRACLE unhurried while primarily two wide for over three-quarters pole, was given his cue at the top of the lane, kicked into gear coming to the eighth pole, finishing with good energy to procure the place. MIKE AND ROB raced along the outside, narrowed the gap under a drive on the far turn, was four wide for the start of the stretch, came home well belatedly for the show. A BETTER TOMORROW three wide on the second bend, flattened out. SIR LESLIE on the rail in the early going, tipped into the two path midway on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch, got straightened away and mustered up a mild response to mainly improve position. CASH YOUR TICKET off the inside, was set down by the five-sixteenths pole, lacked the needed response. KATMANSTU kicked away to a comfortable advantage after the start, was put to encouragement prior to cutting the corner into the lane, yielded during the run through the furlong grounds and backed away. FIDDLERS TANGO hung out three wide on elbow chute, was just as wide upon reaching the full turn, left it six wide and failed to menace. DESAFINADO LIGHT underwent a three to four wide journey for the opening three-quarters, gave way. CAUTION FLAMMABLE saved ground and faltered.
