TAPITDAR along the rail for nearly the entire opening turn, was taken hold and eased back a bit, got taken outward and swung three wide into the backstretch, stalked the front runners from out there making his way down the backstretch, unleashed a run to race into a good striking position by the five-sixteenths pole and went on to challenge for control, entered the stretch and was asked for his best, gave it, kicked away to his biggest advantage during the next eighth, dug in well, kept to a strong drive, to preserve the decision. LOGAN STREET middle-moved along the inside down the backstretch into contention, found space and slipped into the two path in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths marker, bided time under some light coaxing the rest of the way to the head of the stretch, tipped outward one additional path, got asked for run and spun into the stretch, mustered up a solid response en route for the place. BARZINI broke alertly, vied for command from the inside, under a firm hold in the initial stages, had the winner announce his presence as the third fraction was being recorded and was soon let out, surrendered when unable to keep pace, eventually backing away into the show slot. CHARDSEY stumbled after the start, took the inside route during the opening stages, was on the move outward upon entering the far turn, came five wide into upper stretch, flattened out a bit in the late stages. QUIET DANGER raced from off the inside, was put into the three path midway on the far turn, lacked the needed response. GOLDEN TORNADO under encouragement coming six wide into the stretch, improved position. NELSON AVENUE raced along the outside and was through after completing three-quarters. PERFECT SUNDAY in the three path at the three-eighths pole, was outrun. RUN TO CLASS made a three wide run on the first turn to hook up with BARZINI, disputed the pace afterwards closer to the rail thereafter, had the top one arrive on the

scene late on the second bend, continued to press the issue from between rivals to the quarter pole then gave way.
