Footnotes

JONRAH settled into the middle of the field from off the inside, got bumped twice by the runner up as that opponent was forcing his way to the outside midway down the backstretch, regained proper stride shortly afterwards, ranged up into contention on the far turn, maintained the momentum entering the stretch and took off in earnest after the leader under a drive, latched on with an eighth to go, fought his way to the front and kicked clear. MAKE A DECISION sat the pocket in the opening stages, bulled his way to the outside soon after entering the backstretch, forcing the top one slightly to the outside and bumping that foe twice as well during the process, was under a snug grip yet keenly drew abreast of the leader, than being LAWYER JIM, was given some rein and shot past that rival to take over, spurted away and was sent over to the inside, felt pressure coming to the quarter pole and was called upon in response to it, was down to only a narrow advantage by the eighth pole, yielded in short order, continued onward willingly to secure second. LAWYER JIM broke alertly and grabbed the advantage, showed the way during the initial phases from the inside, yielded readily to the winner proceeding towards the half mile pole, took up the pursuit of that foe near the two path on the second bend, entered the stretch, stayed in contention for another furlong then weakened. IN MY EYES off the inside, lacked the needed response. WHY NOT WHISKEY three wide on the opening bend, was guided over to the rail on the backstretch, sat forwardly placed for three-quarters and gave way. PROHIBITION three wide entering the backstretch, failed to menace. JAMES JINGLE placed into the three path coming to the five-sixteenths marker, made no impact. KNOCK QUIETLY along the rail, was briefly in tight quarters, checked on the opening bend, did it again a couple of jumps later, was taken in hand midway down the backstretch, went on to save ground to no avail. POWERFUL INSTINCT tried to rally into contention with a four wide run on the far turn, failed and backed away.
