DREAM LADY set the pace along the inside, dug in resolutely in the stretch and prevailed, her rider inadvertently striking CONNIE BELLE with his whip in the final strides. CONNIE BELLE pressed the pace from the outside and dug in gamely in the stretch and was struck by the winner's whip nearing the wire. BARADORE (IRE) was outrun early, angled out in the stretch and finished gamely outside. ROYAL SANCTION was outrun early, came wide for the drive and was going well late. LA DOLCE VITA raced close up inside, came wide into the stretch and stayed on well outside. K. D.'S SHADY LADY chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. MOYNE ABBEY tired after a half mile. MARLINDSEY had no rally. TIGER ROSE tired badly and was eased in the stretch. Following a Stewards' inquiry, as well as a claim of foul by the rider of the second place finisher against the winner, DREAM LADY was disqualified from first position and placed second for having her rider inadvertently hit CONNIE BELLE with his whip.
