JESS NOT JESSE put to a firm hold, patiently stalked the pacesetter for nearly a half, moved up to issue a challenge for the lead leaving the five-sixteenths pole, struck the front as the field headed into the stretch, opened up a comfortable advantage during the run through the furlong grounds and safely maintained it under good handling. MARKET ANALYSIS tracked the leader from the pocket, angled outward for the stretch drive and got out finished. BILL SENIOR broke well and grabbed command in short order, was guided over to the inside coming to the nine-sixteenths pole, continued to save ground on the turn while setting the pace, came under assault late on the turn, yielded to the winner and weakened steadily throughout the stretch run. MAKE MY DAY KAREN made a three wide run on the turn, attempting to reach a good striking position, spun four wide into the lane but soon flattened out. GALAXY RUSH was urged along while taking the inside route, found room to turn for home in the two path, appeared to make slight contact with FIVESTAR KARAKORUM just past the quarter pole, lacked the needed response. FIVESTAR KARAKORUM gave chase from the outside, came three wide into the stretch, with rivals on either side, appeared to brush with the one along the left side, before backing away. TYMPANIC trailed.
