Footnotes

DYNABROOK was brushed at the start, was four wide departing the backstretch, advanced in tandem with the runner up, scooted by the tiring pacesetter in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home and commenced the stretch duel, wore down RANGEY leaving the eighth pole and edged away, kept to a drive. RANGEY made a successful three wide move to grab the lead during the later stages of the run around the full bend, spun into the stretch with the top one in pursuit, yielded to that rival with less than an eighth to go, held on to be well clear of the others for second. WILLY PAY off the inside, was no match for the top twosome. POWER EMBLEM asked for run by the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home three wide and got out finished. HARDROCKER

saved ground and faltered. GRIFFIN ROCK outrun for nearly three-quarters, lumbered five wide into upper stretch and went by weak and tired ones. CAR TALK (IRE) bumped lightly after the start, rode the rail until midstretch, had no impact. FR. PETER'S MISSAL lightly bumped from both sides at the beginning of the race, failed to be a factor despite saving ground. GODOFGOODFORTUNE failed to menace. TODD COLE tired after going six furlongs. VECTOR loose on the lead in the two path, wilted. FIDDLERS PADRE was through after a half.
