STREET BRAWL grabbed a short lead making his way towards the backstretch, was put to light hand coaxing while cutting the pace from the inside, under the watchful eye of the runner up, continued along on the same scenario until the quarter pole, came out slightly in upper stretch, taking INFLATION TARGET outward as well, resumed a straighter course immediately afterwards, turned back his sole stretch threat, crossing the finish line, hand urged. INFLATION TARGET patiently prompted the winner from the outside, gently hand urged to maintain interest, stayed latched on as the pair made their way down the backstretch and around the bend, got taken in hand when forced outward a path by the top one in upper stretch, resumed the stretch drive under good handling, but had to settle for being second best. FORWARD MARCH tracked the front runners for the opening six furlongs while racing along the inside, under a good hold early, was put to urging angling three wide into the stretch, proved no match. STIRRED UP dropped back early and was never involved. AFRICANIST gave chase from the two path, ducked in coming to the quarter pole, came up empty. COLD CAST underwent a three wide pursuit and folded. Following a General Stewards' Inquiry into the stretch run, as well as a claim of foul lodged by the rider of INFLATION TARGET against the rider of STREET BRAWL alleging interference in the stretch, the result was declared official.
