SKY BLAZER unhurried in midpack along the inside, availed of the opportunity to slip out behind the top threesome at the head of the lane to swing four wide, was put to encouragement, collared the front nearing the three sixteenths and drew clear under a drive to the wire displaying a good kick. LENTENOR forwardly placed three wide in close pursuit, ranged up to engage the front nearing the quarter pole, was let out at that station, never tasted the lead before being overhauled by the aforementioned rival, fought on well through the stretch with good effort to earn the place over an equally determined rival to his inside and prove second best. YANKEE FORTUNE bumped his outside foe at the start, accompanied the pace from the two path, was set down turning for home, took command and led briefly before being displaced nearing the three-sixteenths, battled on determined with LENTENOR through the lane displaying good energy before settling for show honors at the wire. GATHERING CLOUD raced three to four wide at the rear until the three-eighths, shifted into the two path at that station, turned for home engaged by the rider, offered up a mild bid for the last major share while out kicked by the top three. SOUPER SPECTACULAR broke outwards at the start and was corrected before contact could be made with his outside rival, ran well rated three deep from the rail in midpack, came under coaxing midway on the turn, swung four wide in upper stretch and offered no kick. RUSTLER HUSTLER raced between rivals from the two path in midpack, swung three wide for home under a drive and gave no response. COLGAN'S CHIP bumped his outside foe lightly at the start, was forwardly placed just off the inside to set the pace, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, yielded the front spinning for home and weakened in the lane. THE COGNAC KID settled towards the rear along the inside, saved ground throughout and made no impact.
