Footnotes

LA STRADA sat reserved from off the inside during the initial stages, was let out a notch and put into the three path coming to the five-sixteenths marker in preparation for the stretch, narrowed in and was asked for a response spinning into the lane, arrived at the eighth pole with only a sliver of a deficit to make up, did so and kicked away. INDIAN STARLIGHT underwent a three journey, sat perched proceeding down the backstretch keeping watch on the pacesetter, increased her presence once DIAMOND MAKER could not longer keep pace, this occurring around midway on the full turn, disposed of LADY GABY and entered the stretch with none latched on, saw the lead cut down next to nothing by the top one during the ensuing furlong, yielded for good a short distance past the eighth pole, continued onward willingly enough to remain well clear of the other for the place. SAMSONIAN three wide departing the backstretch, advanced steadily into contention racing towards the quarter pole, couldn't sustain the move and backed away. BAY ROAD was sent quickly over to the rail, rode it to the five-sixteenths marker, got taken outward until about three wide at the head of the stretch, lacked the needed response. LOVE IS KEY KAZ three to four wide on the turn, launched no serious moves. HIGH INFLATION was through after completing three-quarters. DIAMOND MAKER pressed the issue from the two path for a bit more than a half and folded. LADY GABY vied for command from the inside, began a steady retreat prior to the quarter pole.
