### Footnotes

THIRD KNIGHT took the inside route for nearly three-quarters, was outrun proceeding along the chute and down the backstretch as well, picked up interest, as did his partner in the two path, that being the runner up, and steadily advanced into contention, starting the march from the half mile pole, was put to urging and angled out sharply coming to the quarter pole, altered course almost a furlong down the road to fill in the space needed to complete a line-up compromised of five with a furlong to go, closed in with good energy to outfinish the competition and prove best. DYKER BEACH was unhurried in the two path during the initial stages, raced into contention alongside the winner upon departing the backstretch, left the five-sixteenths marker under a drive and swung outward, settling into six path by the head of the stretch, came home willingly en route for the place. BRABBHAM kicked away in tandem with RISKY ASSET shortly after the start, was guided over towards the inside, held a slim advantage being rated along as was the previously-mentioned foe, had the rest of the field start to make their presence coming up to the midway point on the turn, was set down for the stretch, having drifted into the two path by the quarter pole, came out slightly more in midstretch, after being given some right handed stick work, relinquished reluctantly and had to settle for the show. ALL THAT latched on to the front runners in the early stages, fell back slightly after entering the backstretch, got let out a notch at the half mile pole and ranged up towards them then was put to much stronger handling an eighth later, entered the stretch locked up in a spirited tussle that was joined by the first two finishers approaching the furlong marker, remained in the thick of things before weakening late. RISKY ASSET raced a team with BRABBHAM as the pair shook free of the others in the early going, was heads apart with that foe for over a half, with both being well rated, had the remaining three close the gap upon departing the backstretch, got asked for a response commencing the stretch three wide, was in tight between rivals for one jump in the vicinity of the eighth pole, battled onward for a little while longer before backing away.
