ALTERNATIVE MEDS sat reserved along the outside until the half mile pole, picked up interest departing that station and edged towards the front runners, unleashed a bold four wide run from the three-eighths pole, turned for home only narrowly behind and was asked for her best, continued to close in readily, forged on ahead with a furlong to go, gained the lead in deep stretch then inched away from a pair of stubborn opponents to prove best. ROSES FOR ROMNEY away with no apparent mishap, kicked away from the others shortly after the start and was guided over to the inside, set the initial splits, being rated along and facing little resistance from the closest chasers, had the pressure intensify a few strides before reaching the quarter pole, directly to the outside, spun into the lane, and got called upon as a spirited tussle involving both the winner and FLIRTATIOUS SPRING commenced, showed good courage refusing to yield during the ensuing furlong, eventually did so but with reluctance in the final stages, continued onward with gameness to secure second. FLIRTATIOUS SPRING contently tracked the front runners from the pocket, was cued up and taken outward, squeezing her way into the two path just before arriving at the end of the bend, got set down, battled gamely wedged between the first two finishers the rest of the way to the wire, having to settle for show honors for the effort. SHE'S ALWAYS HOT mostly two wide to the quarter pole, lacked the needed response. BOURBON TWIST quickly tucked along the rail, rode it all the way to the quarter pole, angled sharply three wide entering the stretch, made no impact. EUROKAY BY ME raced three wide around both turns, folded. MILKYOURWAY off the inside, gave way after going three-quarters. SWIFT TAYLOR broke open the gate, didn't run off and was quickly reloaded and remounted by the pilot, proceeded to come out in good order, assumed the role of primary pursuer, doing so from the two path, needed some urging on the far turn to stay within range of the runner up, gave way.
