FEARLESS JACQ (IRE) attended the pace three wide in hand, advanced to issue a challenge nearing the five-sixteenths, took over narrowly arriving at the quarter pole three wide, inched away under light hand urging to the eighth pole, got set down at that station and edged clear under a drive to the wire. FAB FLOWERS three wide towards the rear unhurried early, came under a ride three furlongs out, spun four wide in to upper stretch, rallied belatedly for the place honors. EXCHANGE CAT two to three wide in mid pack, came under encouragement midway on the turn, continued three wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick for the show honors. COARSEGOLD four wide in pursuit of the front within range, got called upon at the five-sixteenths, swung five wide for home, kicked on to the sixteenth marker in pursuit then was outfinished in the late stages while clear for the last major share. JANE OF ALL TRADES stumbled at the start breaking on top nonetheless, established the pace along the inside under coaxing, had the eventual winner range up at the five-sixteenths in earnest, came under urging in response, got headed at the top of the lane, fought on in contention to the eighth pole before weakening in the late stages. COCONUT SHRIMP tracked inside forwardly placed early on, got urged from three furlongs out, faded steadily nearing the head of the stretch and made no impact. MELLONBROOK saved ground at the rear urged from three furlongs out, angled five wide in upper stretch and trailed throughout.
