SIGHTSEEING was never far back, advanced outside nearing the stretch, came wide for the drive, dug in determinedly outside and was up in the final stride. PROM SHOES argued the pace while three wide, responded when roused turning for home, dug in gamely in the stretch and just missed. FEARLESS VISION raced in hand outside, advanced four wide on the turn and dug in gamely while between rivals in the stretch. HAL'S MY HOPE argued the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. SIR WHIMSEY was urged along inside, raced on the rail and had no response when roused. SOARING BY contested the pace while between rivals and tired after the opening three quarters.
