PINCKNEY HILL was outrun after breaking slowly, moved out on the far turn, swung five wide entering the stretch then closed late in the middle of the track to get up in the final strides. GET STORMY was hard held while saving ground, raced in good position along the inside, waited for room on the turn then rallied strongly along the rail to gain the place. LE GRAND CRU was reserved for five furlongs, rallied three wide to threaten at the quarter pole but couldn't sustain his rally. BIG TOP chased three wide into upper stretch and tired. FOREST BELL steadied in traffic between horses midway on the turn, gained along the inside in midstretch then lacked room in deep stretch. NEMO LANDING set the pace along the rail into midstretch and steadied while tiring near the wire. PRIME DELIVERY was outrun after breaking slowly, raced in traffic on the turn, swung five wide and lacked a rally. ECHO IN ETERNITY was used up battling for the early lead.
