### Footnotes

KINDERGARDEN KID sat patiently perched three wide off the battling pair up front for most of the journey, tipped outward to the four path before swinging into action, took off after the leaders after being given his cue in upper stretch, surged to the front with an eighth to go, then dug in with determination under driving tactics to turn back a late-closing rival and prove best. CHEROKEE SPEED tracked the front runners from the pocket under a firm hold, found room to maneuver out to the two path on the far turn, was forced to continue to bide his time, bottled up amongst rivals, was still in reserve and lacking clear sailing after entering the stretch, angled to the middle of the course once the opportunity presented itself for clearance in upper stretch, commenced his rally when called upon. closed relentlessly during the final furlong, but had to settle for place honors. SPANISH ART entered the backstretch from the two path, sat reserved while not being asked for his best, swung four wide into the lane, displayed a good kick down the outside of the course to garner show honors. ELUSIVE BEAT had a mild rally to improve his position during the stretch run. NEW MADRID vied for the lead from the outside during moderate fractions, was a prominent factor until midstretch before giving way. WILD ENTRY (JPN) within range, was through after completing three-quarters. SYO DEFENCEMAN vied for the lead with NEW MADRID along the rail for six furlongs and tired.
