CATCHAPENNY K. was bumped lightly from both sides after bobbling at the start, angled quickly to the inside shortly afterwards, rode the rail for a short distance, before being placed into the two path, after a couple of opponents dropped over to the inside, remained relatively unhurried during most of the way around the turn, began to pick up the pace, three wide, at the five-sixteenths pole, under some encouragement, was maneuvered back towards the inside, benefiting from several rivals being steadied along in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, closed in readily, grabbed the lead with about a sixteenth remaining and edged clear, driving. STELLALUCE assumed a forward position leaving the starting gate, sat under a snug hold down the backstretch, perched just off a speed battle, moved up eagerly to confront that pair once the grip was released, soon after entering the stretch, battled on nearly even terms, the widest of the threesome, grabbed a narrow lead turning for home, clung to it tenaciously during the ensuing furlong, yielded to the winner near the sixteenth pole but dug in well to preserve the place. KAFFIEND four wide around the turn, finished willingly to earn the show. FIRST PENNY lightly bumped at the start, gradually moved into contention from the outside, was forced to await options from the five-sixteenths pole to the quarter pole, blocked by a wall three deep directly up ahead, and lacking the clearance needed to attempt to swing outward, was asked for a response and loosely drafted behind the runner up after entering the stretch, got shut off and was forced to steady in the vicinity of three-sixteenths pole, losing ground and momentum as a result, got going once more and went to secure the last major award. MAID TO WIN raced along the outside, was put to a prolonged drive and rallied mildly to improve position. GREAT CLIFF raced along the inside, was heavily pressed by a pair of rivals around the turn, drifted out slightly, but apparently just enough to cause some traffic troubles in upper stretch, while starting to back away. KARAKORUM JETE took the inside route while tracking a pace fight and came empty. IN HER HEY DAY disputed the pace between rivals on the turn, appeared to be weakening, when forced to steady in traffic in upper and failed to pick up interest thereafter. AEGEAN BREEZE was lightly bumped at the start, raced off the inside, drifted six wide into the stretch, was eased to the wire

after reaching the eighth pole.
