BOOK REVIEW tracked the pace in behind the front from the two path in midpack, awaited an opening nearing the quarter pole as the front was strung out three abreast, received a seam and was roused swinging three wide for home, displayed a good kick through the final furlong displacing the once clear leader with a sixteenth remaining to prevail going away under a drive. DANCE CARD off a beat slow at the start and was bumped lightly by CLASSIC POINT breaking inwards, entered the turn down along the rail before opting to the three path at the half mile pole, cruised up into contention from the three eighths pole, shifted out one additional path at the five-sixteenths all the while closing on the front, seized command spinning five wide for home, edged clear while moving to the rail with an eighth to go, proved no match when confronted by the aforementioned rival in the final sixteenth succumbing the front at that juncture, while safely second best. ROYAL RHIANNON chased the pace four wide from close range, came under urging at the quarter pole, kicked on mildly through the lane to be along for the show. SCAMPERING hustled inside early on, saved ground down along the rail through the turn, was let out nearing the head of the lane, angled out to the three path at the three-sixteenths, kicked on with late energy for the last major share. GLORIOUS VIEW set a solid pace from the two path under some pressure, was let out at the quarter pole, got displaced on the front and tired. FREE AS A BIRD contested the pace three wide, was set down at the head of the stretch and offered no kick. LUCH'S TONY P raced just off the inside towards the rear and never threatened. CLASSIC POINT broke in at the start bumping lightly with DANCE CARD and was taken off that rival, chased the pace from afar and offered little. AL ANDALEEB outrun early on, chased while wide and proved no factor.
