BUDAPEST GIRL contested the pace from the outside and dug in gamely along the inside in the stretch. LIL LINZER was outrun early, rallied three wide approaching the stretch and finished well outside. GEBB'S DIXIE was outrun early, came wide for the drive and was going well late. OATKA IDAS DESTINY chased the pace from the outside and lacked a rally. CECILIA'S GIRL had no rally. WITHORWITHOUTYOU chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. MISS BALOO tired after a half mile. RIVER'S SOLUTION raced wide and tired. CURE JUDYS BLUES tired after an inside trip.
