SNOWDROPS (GB) was rated along inside, angled out into the stretch, split rivals, finished strongly and was along in time. POTRA FABULOUS (ARG) was rated along inside, saved ground and finished gamely on the rail. VESPERS raced in hand outside early, rallied three wide on the turn and dug in gamely in the stretch. BRANDALA was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside. LOJO was unhurried early, put in a run from the outside on the turn and weakened in the final furlong. REBRIDLED DREAMS posed no real threat. LEEBEARSKI chased the pace along the inside and tired. MA FEMME ran off to a long lead, set the pace and drifted out while tiring in the stretch.
